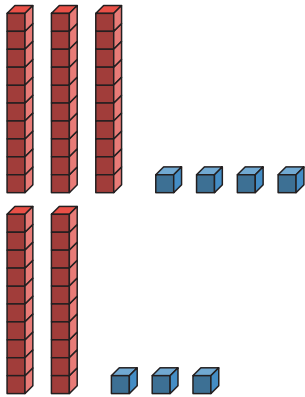


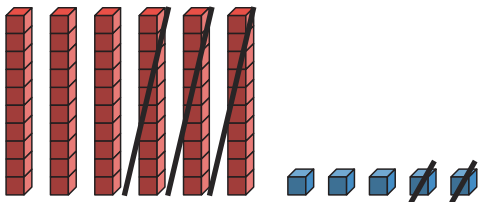
Addition and Subtraction within 100 with Base Ten

Then, solve the addition and subtraction calculations.



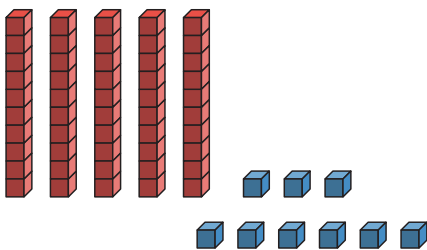
